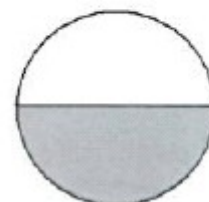

To be viewed and judged from the front
- Class 3 THE MIDAS TOUCH**
Novice Class - An exhibit
To include gold fabric
Space allowed: width 91cm, depth 76cm, height 107cm
Staged on dove grey tabling and background
To be viewed and judged from the front
- Class 4 ILLUMINATED CAPITAL LETTER**
Craft Class - An exhibit
Space allowed: width 20cm, height 25cm, maximum depth 5cm
To be staged on an easel on a circular table with dove grey staging
To be viewed and judged from the front
- Class 5 MARDI GRAS**
Imposed Class - An exhibit
Space allowed: width 91cm, depth 76cm, height optional
Staged on dove grey tabling and background
To be viewed and judged from the front

Class 6 THE PHILOSOPHER'S STONE
Abstract Class - An exhibit
Space allowed: width 60cm, depth 60cm, height optional
Staged on individual dove grey stands 60cm square,
104 cm from the floor
To be viewed and judged all round

Class 7 MOONLIGHT SERENADE
An exhibit
Space allowed: one-half of a circular table,
diameter 148cm, height 74cm
Staged on a dove grey circular table with a semi-
circular dove grey background
To be viewed and judged from the front



Class 8 A MEASURE OF TIME
An exhibit
Space allowed: one third-circle segment, radius
74cm, height 74cm
Staged on a dove grey circular table with dove
grey background
To be viewed and judged from the front



Class 9 HERE AND NOW
An exhibit:
To interpret a topical event - title to be stated
Space allowed: width 107cm, depth 107cm, height 213cm
Staged on a floor standing dove grey base 107cm square
To be viewed all round and judged from the front

Class 10 LITTLE GEMS
Junior Class
An exhibit:
Jewellery
Space allowed: width 30cm, depth 30cm
Staged on dove grey open tabling
To be viewed and judged from the front

Class 11 WHERE MERMAIDS LIE

Petite - An exhibit

Space allowed: width 25cm, depth 25cm, height 25cm

Staged on a grey card provided, on a Perspex stand 15cm high on dove grey tabling

To be viewed and judged from the front

Class 12 GOLD FILIGREE

Miniature - An exhibit

Space allowed: width 10cm, depth 10cm, height 10cm

Staged on a grey square card provided, on a black stand approximately 128cm high

To be viewed and judged from the front

Class 13 COOL BUT CREATIVE

An exhibit

Space allowed: width 91cm, depth 74cm, height 40cm

Staged on dove grey open tabling

Two long 49cm grey trays provided which must be used

To be viewed all round and judged from the front

Class 14 SNAIL TRAIL

An exhibit

Space allowed: width 91cm, depth 76cm, height optional

Staged on dove grey tabling and background

To be viewed and judged from the front

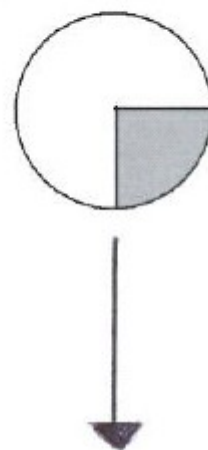
Class 15 OUT OF THE BLUE

An exhibit

Space allowed: one quarter circle segment, radius 74cm, height 74cm

Staged on a dove grey circular table with dove grey background.

To be viewed and judged from the front



SHOW RULES

1. The competition is open to all Members of Societies affiliated to the Kent Area of NAFAS.
2. All exhibits will be judged in accordance with the Competitions Manual Second Edition 2009. Judging will take place on Thursday 11 August commencing at 3.00pm.
THE JUDGES' DECISION WILL BE FINAL.
3. Exhibits must be staged within the space allocated and be the competitor's own original work not previously exhibited in its entirety. All exhibits must be assembled in the hall with the exception of Classes 4,10,11,12 where exhibits may be submitted ready assembled. The staging for Class 5 (Imposed Class) will be on Wednesday 10 August commencing 6.00pm and concluding 8.00pm.
Some of each of the provided components must be used.
4. Entries must be made on the OFFICIAL ENTRY FORM and returned to the Competition Secretary enclosing a stamped addressed envelope. Entrants will be notified in writing whether or not their entries have been accepted. Exhibitors may place only one entry in each class.
5. Individual entries will be accepted in strict order of application with a closing date of 29 July 2011.
6. A Novice is one who has never won a first prize at an Area or National Show.
7. Winners of Classes 1, 4, 5, 10, 11, 12 are **not eligible** for the Best in Show or Runner-up to Best in Show Awards.
8. Staging times: Wednesday 10 August from 2.00 pm until 8.00 pm and Thursday 11 August from 8.00 am until 1.30 pm
Only Officials and Competitors will be allowed in the Hall during staging time. Please wear your competitor's badge at all times. **Permission will be given to dismantle exhibits after prize giving on Saturday 13 August.**
9. All measurements shown in the schedule are **approximate**. The tabling will be approximately 72cm from the floor unless otherwise stated. Staging fabric (tabling & background) is as stated in Schedule. Tables will be covered with protective covering.

10. No attachments will be permitted to the backgrounds provided.
11. Aerosol sprays and paints of any kind are not permitted inside or outside the premises.
12. During staging it is not permitted to use any table top space other than that allocated to you.
13. Maintenance of exhibits may be carried out between 9.00 am and 10.00am on Friday 12 and Saturday 13 August.
14. All exhibits and competitors' property will be at the risk of the competitor; neither the Kent Area of NAFAS nor The Lordswood Leisure Centre Limited can accept any liability whatsoever for any loss or damage sustained by any competitor.
15. Photographs taken during staging times must be with the exhibitor's consent. Any photographs taken are for personal use and may not be used commercially.
16. **Prizes:** Class 1: £30.00 £15.00 £10.00
 All other classes: £15.00 £10.00 £5.00
 Excluding Junior Class 10 where all exhibitors will receive a Certificate.
17. Entry fees are £3.00 per entry in Class 1. All other Class entry fees are £2 with the exception of the Imposed Class 5. The entry fee for Class 5 will be £25 where all components will be provided and will become the property of the competitor.
18. **JUNIOR CLASSES** - Exhibits to be submitted already assembled.
 There is no entry fee for Class 10 and it is not necessary to be a member of an affiliated club. A junior is a person under the age of 17 years at the time of entry. The class will be judged in three age groups: 5 to 8, 9 to 11 and 12 to 17. Please state date of birth on entry form.
19. Cancellation of any exhibit should be confirmed in writing
No refunds will be made.

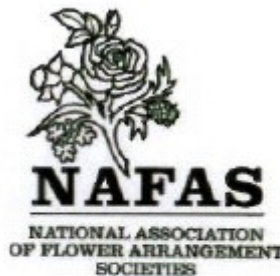
