

RULES

- 1 **Classes 1-5:** The competition is open to all NAFAS members who have paid their affiliation fee, except for members of the National Photographic Committee who may not enter the competition.
Class 6 is open to junior members of any club affiliated to NAFAS.
- 2 Entry Fee: Class 6 Juniors - no charge. All others: £1 per photograph - maximum of three entries in each class.
- 3 No photograph that has won a NAFAS award may be entered more than once in any NAFAS National Photographic Competition.
- 4 No photograph may be entered in more than one class.
- 5 The following details must be attached to, or written on, the back of each mounted photograph:
Class number and title
Competitors name and address
NAFAS Club and Area
The top of the photograph must be indicated
In Class 6 the competitors age must be stated.
- 6 Entrants submitting photographs of floral exhibits should, if possible, acknowledge the arranger or state if the exhibit is the photographer's own work.
- 7 The judge's decision is final.
- 8 All photographs must be taken by the competitor.
- 9 Please enclose a stamped addressed envelope/label for the return of prints.
- 10 Every care will be taken of entries, but NAFAS cannot be held responsible for entries that are lost, damaged or delayed. Proof of posting cannot be accepted as proof of delivery

Use hard backed envelopes if at all possible and separate photographs with tissue paper (or similar). If padded envelopes are used, ensure that the prints are protected by cardboard larger than the mounted photograph.

- It is suggested that competitors do not use large quantities of adhesive tape as it can be a hazard to the surface of other prints. Masking tape is preferable.
- Any writing should always be on the back of the mount.
- On no account should paper clips, staples, etc be used on the mounts.
- Digital imaging is permitted. No manipulation except in **Class 4**.
- Competitors are required to send a completed entry form with their photographs. Photocopies of the entry form are acceptable on any colour of paper.

CLASS 1 FINISHING TOUCHES The Doris Madeley Trophy.
A colour print of a contemporary floral design.

CLASS 2 CHASING YESTERDAY The North Midlands Trophy.
A black and white or grey scale print.

CLASS 3 BASKETS OF DELIGHT The Coles Trophy.
Novice Class* A colour print of plants and/or flowers,
*A novice is defined as a member who has not previously won a prize in a NAFAS National Photographic Competition.

CLASS 4 THINGS TO COME The Surrey Trophy.
A digital print of plants and/or flowers, to demonstrate imaginative manipulation. Please attach a 6"x4" copy of the original to demonstrate the changed image.

CLASS 5 IN THE MIDST OF THINGS The East of England Trophy.
A close up photographic detail of natural plant material.

CLASS 6 GATHERED TREASURES Junior Trophy.
A colour print to interpret the class title.

Images must be no larger than 10" x 8" (approx. 25 x 20 cm) in all classes, and should be mounted with overall dimensions not exceeding 12" x 10" (approx. 30 x 25 cm)
