

NAFAS – Coronavirus Statement

We are monitoring the Coronavirus (COVID-19) situation very carefully and regularly, and following advice and guidelines set by the Government, the World Health Organisation and the UK NHS.

The health and safety of our members, staff and visitors is our priority.

We ask our club and area officers to ensure that hand sanitiser gel is made available at all meetings and the following guidelines are read out to those assembled as part of the meeting introduction statement.

- Wash your hands with soap and water often – do this for at least 20 seconds
- Always wash your hands when you get home or into work
- Use hand sanitizer gel if soap and water are not available
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze
- Put used tissues in the bin straight away and wash your hands afterwards
- Try to avoid close contact with people who are unwell
- DO NOT touch your eyes, nose or mouth if your hands are not clean

Until guidelines from the Government change there is currently no recommendation from NAFAS to cancel a meeting unless a case of Coronavirus has been identified within the Club, Area or Head office. The terms and conditions of the NAFAS Code of Practice will apply to all cancellations of JDS&E.

If there are any changes to the current recommendations from the Government or the World Health Organisation, we will review and react to their instructions promptly.
