Student Subject Unit Outline

Total of 30 hours class time. 10 x 3-hour classes.

To complete the Flower Arranging Part 2 course - Students as a group in class will complete their Student Diary of Work which includes, creating a practical design, taking a photo, identifying materials & sundries. Evaluate your design.

Class 1

Complete a symmetrical design showing good use of the Elements and Principles of Design

Class 2

Complete a design of tutor's choice showing good use of the Elements and Principles of Design

Class 3

Complete a design of tutor's choice using any type of floral foam, Agra wool or Fibre Floral.

Class 4

Complete a design of tutor's choice using wire mesh in a container as support for stems in water

Class 5

Complete a wreath design using moss as a base.

Class 6

Complete a design using a structure for a container or a vase

Class 7

Make a free-standing structure with test tubes and complete a design using it.

Class 8

Complete a design incorporating at least 2 different styles of leaf manipulation

Class 9

Complete a design using a grid as a means of supporting stems in water

Class 10

Complete a modern design inspired by the Victorian period.
